

13. The Apostles

Simon - Son of John - Jesus named him Peter (Mark 3:16) or Cephas (John 1:42) which means a stone. He was a Fisherman.

Andrew - aka Levi

James - Son of Zebedee

John - James brother. - The one whom Jesus loved. (John 20:2; 21:20) - Jesus named him Boanerges which means son of thunder. (Mark 3:17)

Philip

Bartholomew - Nathanael-the true Israelite in whom there is nothing false. (John 1:45-46)

Matthew - Tax collector.

Thomas - called Didymus (John 20:24)

James - Son of Alphaeus

Simon - called the Zealot

Judas - Son of James (Luke 6:16)

Judas Iscaiot - became the traitor

Matthias - replaced Judas Iscaiot (Acts 1:12-26)

Paul - Saul of Tarsus (Act 9:11, 1-19)
