God Provides

...the Lord shall give you in the evening flesh to eat, and in the morning bread to the full...And it came to pass, that at [eve] the quails came up and covered the camp: and in the morning the dew lay round ...and when the dew that lay was gone up, behold, upon the face of the wilderness there lay a small round thing...it is manna... (Exodus 16:8,13-14,15)

Strike the rock, and water will come out of it for the people to drink. (Exodus 17:6b NIV)
