24. Prayer

"And when <u>you pray</u>, do not be like the <u>hypocrites</u>, for they love to pray <u>standing</u> in the <u>synagogues</u> and on the <u>street</u> corners to be seen by men...But when you pray, go into your <u>room</u>, <u>close</u> the <u>door</u> and pray to your <u>Father</u>, who is <u>unseen</u>. Then your <u>Father</u>, who sees what is done in <u>secret</u>, will <u>reward</u> you. And when you pray, do not keep on <u>babbling</u> like <u>pagans</u>, for they think they will be <u>heard</u> because of their many words....for your <u>Father knows</u> what you need before you <u>ask him</u>. (Matthew 6:5-8 NIV)

... Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins. (Mark 11:24-25 NIV)
