

26. The Fall of Jericho

Now Jericho was straitly shut up because of the children of Israel: none went out, and none came in. And the Lord said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour. (Joshua 6:1-2 KJV)

And Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priest took up the ark of the Lord. And seven priest bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the Lord went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the ark of the Lord, the priest going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

And the second day they compassed the city once and returned into the camp: so they did six days. And it came to pass on the seventh day, that hey rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times. And it came to pass at the seven the time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, SHOUT; for the Lord hath given you the city.

And the city shall be accursed even it, and all that are herein, to the Lord: only Rehab the harlot shall live, she and all that are with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent....the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.
