30. Seed

A seed produces after it's own kind: (reap what you sow)

Then God said, "Let the land <u>produce</u> vegetation: <u>seed-bearing plants</u> and <u>trees</u> on the land that bear <u>fruit</u> with seed in it, according to their <u>various kinds</u>." And it was so. The land produced <u>vegetation</u>: plants bearing seed according to their kinds and trees bearing fruit with seed in it according to their kinds. (Genesis 1:11-12 NIV)

Remember this: Whoever <u>sows</u> sparingly will also <u>reap</u> <u>sparingly</u>, and whoever sows generously will also reap <u>generously</u>. (2 Corinthians 9:6 NIV)

"Give, and it will be given to you. A good <u>measure</u>, <u>pressed</u> down, <u>shaken together</u> and <u>running</u> over, will be poured into your <u>lap</u>. For with the measure you <u>use</u>, it will be measured to you." (Luke 8:38 NIV)

A season to plant and a season to harvest:

While the <u>earth remain</u>eth, seedtime and <u>harvest</u> ... shall not <u>cease</u> (Genesis 8:22 KJV)

To every thing there is a <u>season</u>, and a time to every <u>purpose</u> under the heaven: A time to be <u>born</u>, and a time to <u>die</u>; a time to <u>plant</u>, and a time to <u>pluck</u> up that which is planted... (Ecclesiastes 3:1-2 KJV)

Whoever <u>watches</u> the <u>wind</u> will not plant; whoever looks at the <u>clouds</u> will not reap. (Ecclesiastes 11:4 NIV)

He that gathereth in $\underline{\text{summer}}$ is a wise son: but he that $\underline{\text{sleep}}$ eth in harvest is a son that causeth $\underline{\text{shame}}$. (Proverbs 10:5 KJV)

"I tell you, <u>open</u> your <u>eyes</u> and look at the <u>fields</u>! They are ripe for harvest." (John 4:35 NIV)
