33. Blindness

Having the understanding <u>darkened</u>, being <u>alienated</u> from the life of God through the <u>ignorance</u> that is in them, because of the <u>blind</u>ness of <u>their heart</u>: (Ephesians 4:18 KJV)

But if our gospel be hid, it is <u>hid</u> to them that are lost. In <u>whom</u> the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the <u>glorious</u> gospel of Christ, who is the <u>image</u> of God should shine unto them. (2 Corinthians 4:3-4 KJV)

"Can the blind \underline{lead} the blind? Shall they not both fall into the \underline{ditch} ?" (Luke 6:39 KJV)

"...The man who $\underline{\text{walks}}$ in the dark does not know where he is going." (John 12:35 NIV)

Speak to each other about these things every day while there is still time, so that none of you will <u>become hard</u>ened against God, being blinded by the <u>glamour</u> of sin. (Hebrews 3:13 TLB)

And I will bring the blind by a way that they know not; I will lead them in paths that they have not known: I will make darkness light before them, and <u>crooked</u> things straight. These things will I do unto them, and not forsake them. (Isaiah 42:16 KJV)

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, "I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life." (John 8:12 KJV)

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor, he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and <u>recovering</u> sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised. To Preach the acceptable year of the Lord." (Luke 4:18-19 KJV)

[I pray that] the eyes of your understanding being <u>enlightened</u>: that you may know what is the hope of his <u>calling</u>, and what the riches of the glory of his <u>inheritance</u> in the saints, And what is the <u>exceeding great</u>ness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, which he <u>wrought</u> in Christ when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly <u>places</u>. (Ephesians 1:18-20 KJV)
