34. Solomon's Wisdom

In <u>Gibeon</u> the Lord appeared to <u>Solomon</u> in a dream by night: and God said, Ask what I shall give thee.

Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee. The woman whose son was alive was filled with <u>compassion</u>... "Please, my lord, give her the living baby! Don't kill him!"

But the other said, "Neither I nor you shall have him. Cut him in two." Then the king gave his <u>ruling</u>: " Give the living baby to the first

woman. Do not kill him; she is his mother."
