49. The Flood - Noah

The Lord saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every <u>inclination</u> of his heart was only evil all the time. The Lord was <u>grieved</u> that he had made man on the earth, and his heart was filled with pain. So the Lord said, I will <u>wipe mankind</u>, whom I have created ... (Genesis 6:5-7 NIV)

But <u>Noah</u> found favor in the eyes of the Lord. Noah was righteous man, <u>blameless</u> among the people of this time, and he walked with God. Noah had three sons: <u>Shem</u>, <u>Ham</u> and <u>Japheth</u>. (Genesis 6:8-10 NIV)

Now the earth was corrupt in God's <u>sight</u> and full of <u>violence</u>...So god said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people...So make yourself and <u>ark</u> of <u>cypress wood</u>; make rooms in it and coat it with <u>pitch inside</u> and out...I'm going to bring <u>floodwaters</u> on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens...But I am going to establish my covenant with you...You are to bring into the ark two al all living creatures, male and female to keep them alive with you... (Genesis 6:11, 13, 14, 17, 18, 19 NIV)

Noah did everything just as the Lord commanded him...The Lord then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and your whole family, because I found you righteous in this <u>generation</u>. Take with you seven of every kind of clean animal...and two of every kind of unclean animal...(Genesis 6:22, 7:1-2 NIV)

Noah was <u>six</u> hundred years old when the floodwaters came on the earth. For forty days and <u>forty</u> nights the flood kept coming on the earth, and as the waters increased they <u>lifted</u> the ark, high above the earth. The waters flooded the earth for a hundred and fifty days. But God remember Noah and all the wild animals and <u>livestock</u> that were with him in the ark and he sent a <u>wild</u> wind over the earth, and the waters <u>receded</u>. (Genesis 7:5, 17, 24, 8:1 NIV)

So Noah came out...then Noah built an alter to the Lord...Then God blessed Noah..."Be <u>fruitful</u> and increase in <u>number</u>, and fill the earth...Never again will the waters become a flood to destroy all life. Whenever the <u>rainbow</u> appears in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and all living creatures..."
