## 65. John The Baptist

There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest name <u>Zechariah</u>...they had no child because that Elisabeth was <u>barren</u>, and they were now well <u>stricken</u> in years...Then an <u>angel</u> of the Lord [<u>Gabriel</u>, v. 19] appeared to him..."thy wife <u>Elizabeth</u> shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John. And thou shall have joy and <u>gladness</u>...he shall be filled with the Holy <u>Ghost</u>, even from his mother's <u>womb</u>...in the spirit and power of <u>Elijah</u>" (Luke 1:5, 7, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19 KJV)

John the Baptist came preaching in the Desert of <u>Judea</u> and saying, "<u>Repent</u> for the kingdom of heaven is near." This is he who was spoken of through the prophet <u>Isaiah</u>:

"A voice of one calling in the desert,

Prepare the way for the Lord,

Make straight paths for him." [Isaiah 40:3]

John's clothes were made of <u>camel</u>'s <u>hair</u>, and he had a <u>leather</u> belt around his <u>waist</u>. His food was <u>locusts</u> and wild honey. People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole <u>region</u> of the Jordan. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.

I will <u>baptize</u> you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to e baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" Jesus replied, "Let it be so now, it is <u>proper</u> for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness." Then John consented. (Matthew 3:1-6, 11, 13-15 NIV)

Then there arose a <u>question</u> between some of John's disciples and the Jews about <u>purifying</u>. And they came unto John and said unto him, Rabbi, he that was with thee beyond Jordan, to whom thou barest <u>witness</u>, behold, the same baptizeth, and all men come to him.
