## 67. Cain and Abel

And Adam knew Eve his wife: and she conceived, and <u>bare Cain</u>, and said, I have <u>gotten</u> a man from the Lord. And she again bare his brother <u>Abel</u>. And Abel was a <u>keeper</u> of sheep, but Cain was a <u>tiller</u> of the <u>ground</u>. And in the <u>process</u> of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an <u>offering</u> unto the Lord. And Abel he also brought of the <u>fristlings</u>, of his <u>flock</u> and of the <u>fat</u> thereof. And the Lord had <u>respect</u> unto Able and to his offering: But unto Cain and his offering he had no respect. And Cain was very <u>wroth</u>, and his countenance fell.

And the Lord said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? And why is the countenance fallen? If thou does well, shalt thou not be accepted? And if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shall <u>rule</u> over him.

An Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the <u>field</u>, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and <u>slew</u> him. And the Lord came to Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper? And he said, What hast thou done?
