68. What is Man?

When I <u>consider</u> thy heavens, the work of thy <u>fingers</u>, the <u>moon</u> and the <u>stars</u>, which thou hast <u>ordained</u>:

What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thous <u>visit</u>est him?
