

14. Fathers - Proverbs

(King James Version)

My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother: For they *shall be* an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck. My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not. (1:8-10)

For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son *in whom* he delighteth. (3:11)

Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding. For I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law. For I was my father's son, tender and only beloved in the sight of my mother. He taught me ... Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live. Get wisdom, get understanding: forget *it* not; neither decline from the words of my mouth. (4:1-5)

The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son *is* the heaviness of his mother. (10:1) A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man despiseth his mother. (15:20)

He that begetteth a fool *doeth it* to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy ... A foolish son *is* a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him. (17:21, 25)

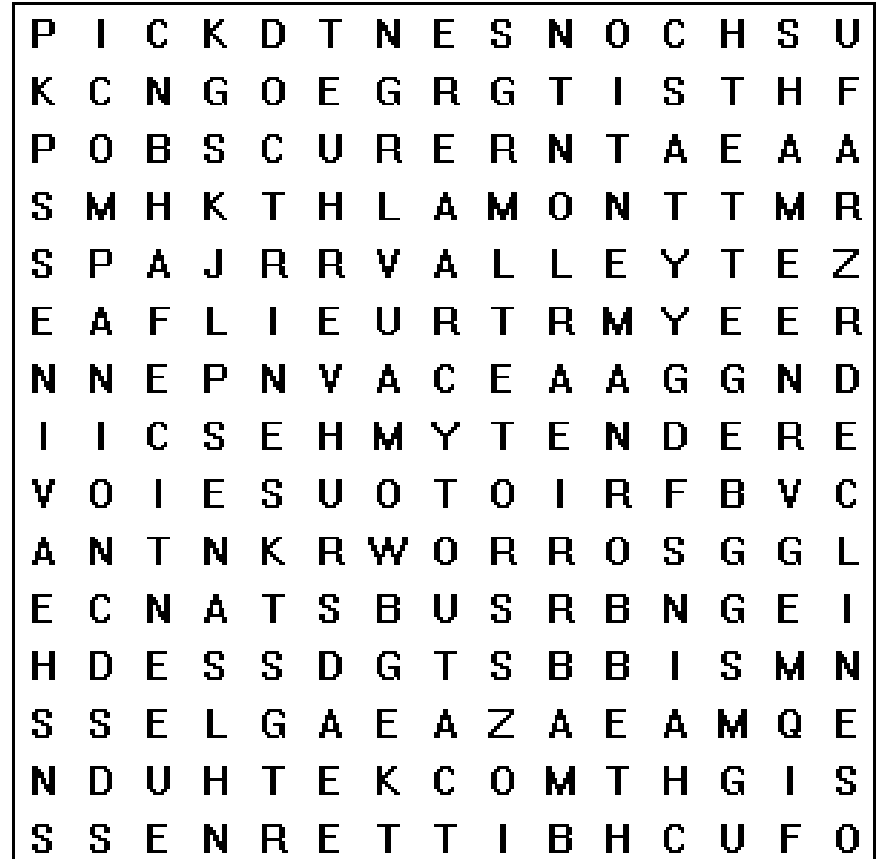
A foolish son *is* the calamity of his father ... He that wasteth *his* father, and chaseth away *his* mother, *is* a son that causeth shame, and bringeth reproach. (19:13, 26) Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness. (20:20)

Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old ... The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise *child* shall have joy of him. Thy father and thy mother shall be glad, and she that bare thee shall rejoice. (23:22, 24-25)

Whoso keepeth the law *is* a wise son: but he that is a companion of riotous men shameth his father ... Whoso robbeth his father or his mother, and saith, *It is* no transgression... *is* the companion of a destroyer. (28:7, 24)

Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his father: but he that keepeth company with harlots spendeth *his* substance. (29:3)

There is a generation *that* curseth their father, and doth not bless their mother... The eye *that* mocketh at *his* father, and despiseth to obey *his* mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it. (30:11, 17)
