## 14. Fathers - Proverbs

## (King James Version)

My son, hear the <u>instruction</u> of thy father, and <u>forsake</u> not the law of thy mother: For they *shall be* an <u>ornament</u> of grace unto thy head, and <u>chains</u> about thy <u>neck</u>. My son, if sinners <u>entice</u> thee, <u>consent</u> thou not. (1:8-10)

For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son *in whom* he delighteth. (3:11)

Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding. For I give you good <u>doctrine</u>, forsake ye not my law. For I was my father's son, <u>tender</u> and only *beloved* in the <u>sight</u> of my mother. He taught me ... Let thine heart <u>retain</u> my words: keep my commandments, and live. Get wisdom, get understanding: forget *it* not; neither <u>decline</u> from the words of my mouth. (4:1-5)

The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son *is* the <u>heaviness</u> of his mother. (10:1) A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man despiseth his mother. (15:20)

He that <u>begetteth</u> a fool *doeth it* to his <u>sorrow</u>: and the father of a fool hath no joy ... A foolish son *is* a grief to his father, and <u>bitterness</u> to her that bare him. (17:21, 25)

A foolish son *is* the calamity of his father ... He that wasteth *his* father, *and* chaseth away *his* mother, *is* a son that causeth <u>shame</u>, and bringeth reproach. (19:13, 26) Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his <u>lamp</u> shall be put out in <u>obscure</u> darkness. (20:20)

Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old ... The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise *child* shall have joy of him. Thy father and thy mother shall be glad, and she that bare thee shall rejoice. (23:22, 24-25)

Whoso keepeth the law *is* a wise son: but he that is a <u>companion</u> of <u>riotous</u> *men* shameth his father ... Whoso <u>robbeth</u> his father or his mother, and saith, *It is* no transgression... *is* the companion of a <u>destroyer</u>. (28:7, 24)

Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his father: but he that keepeth company with <u>harlots</u> spendeth *his* <u>substance</u>. (29:3)

*There is* a generation *that* curseth their father, and doth not bless their mother... The eye *that* <u>mocketh</u> at *his* father, and despiseth to obey *his* mother, the <u>ravens</u> of the <u>valley</u> shall <u>pick</u> it out, and the young <u>eagles</u> shall eat it. (30:11, 17)
