16. Hamor

Jacob bought the land he camped on from the family of <u>Hamor</u>, Shechem's father, for a hundred <u>pieces</u> of <u>silver</u>. (Genesis 33:19 NLT)

One day <u>Dinah</u>, Leah's daughter, went to visit some of the young women who lived in the area. But when the local <u>prince</u>, <u>Shechem</u> son of Hamor the <u>Hivite</u>, saw her, he took her and <u>raped</u> her.

Meanwhile, Hamor, Shechem's father, came out to discuss the <u>matter</u> with Jacob. He arrived just as Jacob's sons were coming in from the fields. They were <u>shocked</u> and <u>furious</u> that their sister had been raped. Shechem had done a disgraceful thing against Jacob's family, a thing that should never have been done. Hamor told Jacob and his sons, "My son Shechem is truly in love with your daughter, and he <u>longs</u> for her to be his wife. Please let him marry her.

But Dinah's brothers <u>deceived</u> Shechem and Hamor because of what Shechem had done to their sister. They said to them, "We couldn't possibly allow this, because you aren't <u>circumcised</u>. It would be a disgrace for her to marry a man like you!

Hamor and Shechem <u>gladly agreed</u>, and Shechem lost no time in acting on this request, for he wanted Dinah <u>desperately</u>. Shechem was a highly <u>respected</u> member of his family, and he <u>appeared</u> with his father before the town leaders to present this proposal.

So all the men agreed and were circumcised. But three days later, when their <u>wounds</u> were still sore, two of Dinah's brothers, <u>Simeon</u> and Levi, took their swords, entered the town without opposition, and <u>slaughtered</u> every man there, including Hamor and Shechem. They rescued Dinah from Shechem's house and returned to their camp. Then all of Jacob's sons <u>plundered</u> the town because their sister had been <u>defiled</u> there. They also took all the women and children and <u>wealth</u> of every kind. Afterward Jacob said to Levi and Simeon, "You have made me stink among all the people of this land – among all the <u>Canaanites</u> and <u>Perizzites</u>. We are so few that they will come and <u>crush</u> us. We will all be killed!" "Should he treat our sister like a prostitute?" they <u>retorted angrily</u>. (Genesis 34:1-2, 6-8, 13-15, 18-20, 24-27, 29-30 NLT)
