22. Jacob Blesses His Twelve Sons

Jacob called unto his sons ... Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the last days ...

Reuben, thou art my <u>firstborn</u>, my might ... beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity ... the excellency of power: <u>Unstable</u> as water, thou shalt not excel; because thou wentest up to thy father's bed ... <u>defiledst</u> thou it ...

Simeon and Levi are ... instruments of <u>cruelty</u> are in their habitations. O my soul, come not thou into their secret; unto their assembly, mine honour, be not thou united: for in their anger they <u>slew</u> a man, and in their <u>selfwill</u> they <u>digged</u> down a wall. Cursed be their anger, for it was <u>fierce</u>; and their wrath, for it was cruel: I will divide them in Jacob, and <u>scatter</u> them in Israel.

Judah, thou art he whom thy brethren shall praise: thy hand shall be in the neck of thine <u>enemies</u>; thy father's children shall bow down before thee ... a lion's <u>whelp</u>: from the prey ... thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as ... an old lion; who shall <u>rouse</u> him up? The <u>sceptre</u> shall not depart from Judah, nor a <u>lawgiver</u> from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be ...

Zebulun shall dwell at the haven of the sea; and he shall be for an haven of ships; and his border shall be unto Zidon.

Issachar is a strong ass couching down between two <u>burdens</u>: And he saw that rest was good, and the land that it was pleasant; and bowed his shoulder to bear, and became a servant unto <u>tribute</u>.

Dan shall judge his people, as one of the tribes of Israel ... a serpent by the way, an <u>adder</u> in the path, that biteth the horse <u>heels</u>, so that his rider shall fall backward. I have waited for thy salvation, O LORD.

Gad, a troop shall overcome him: but he shall overcome at the last.

Out of Asher his bread shall be fat, and he shall yield royal dainties.

Naphtali is a hind let loose: he giveth goodly words.

Joseph is a fruitful bough ... by a well; whose <u>branches</u> run over the wall: The <u>archers</u> have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him: But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the mighty God of Jacob; (from thence is the <u>shepherd</u>, the stone of Israel:) Even by the God of thy father, who shall help thee; and by the Almighty, who shall bless thee with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the <u>deep</u> that lieth under, blessings of the breasts, and of the <u>womb</u> ...

Benjamin shall ravin as a wolf: in the morning he shall <u>devour</u> the prey, and at night he shall divide the <u>spoil</u>.

All these are the twelve tribes of Israel ... that their father blessed them; every one according to his blessing he blessed them. And he charged them, and said unto them, I am to be gathered unto my people: <u>bury</u> me with my fathers in the <u>cave</u> that is in the field of Ephron the Hittite ... (Genesis 49:1-29 KJV)
