28. Joseph

Before the years of <u>famine</u> came, two sons were born to <u>Joseph</u> by <u>Asenath</u> daughter of <u>Potiphera</u>, priest of <u>On</u>. Joseph named his <u>firstborn Manasseh</u> and said, "It is because God has made me <u>forget</u> all my <u>trouble</u> and all my father's <u>household</u>." The second son he named <u>Ephraim</u> and said, "It is because God has made me <u>fruitful</u> in the land of my <u>suffering</u>."

The seven years of <u>abundance</u> in Egypt came to an end, and the seven years of famine began, just as Joseph had said. There was famine in all the other lands, but in the whole land of Egypt there was food. When all Egypt began to feel the famine, the people cried to <u>Pharaoh</u> for food. Then Pharaoh told all the Egyptians, "Go to Joseph and do what he tells you."

When the famine had <u>spread</u> over the <u>whole</u> country, Joseph <u>opened</u> the <u>storehouses</u> and <u>sold grain</u> to the Egyptians, for the famine was severe throughout Egypt. And all the countries came to Egypt to buy grain from Joseph, because the famine was <u>severe</u> in all the world. (Genesis 41:50-57 NIV)

When <u>Jacob</u> learned that there was grain in Egypt, he said to his sons, "Why do you just keep looking at each other?" ... ten of Joseph's brothers went down to buy grain from Egypt. 4 But Jacob did not send <u>Benjamin</u>, Joseph's brother, with the others, because he was afraid that <u>harm</u> might come to him. (Genesis 42:1-4 NIV)

And God spoke to Israel in a <u>vision</u> at night and said, "Jacob! Jacob!"

"Here I am," he replied.

"I am God, the God of your father," he said. "Do not be <u>afraid</u> to go down to Egypt, for I will make you into a <u>great nation</u> there. I will go down to Egypt with you, and I will surely bring you back again. And Joseph's own hand will close your eyes." Then Jacob left Beersheba ... (Genesis 46:2-5 NIV)
