3. A Father's Discipline – Proverbs

(Proverbs)

My son, do not <u>despise</u> or shrink from the <u>chastening</u> of the Lord [His correction by punishment or by <u>subjection</u> to <u>suffering</u> or <u>trial</u>]; neither be <u>weary</u> of or <u>impatient</u> about or <u>loathe</u> or <u>abhor</u> His <u>reproof</u>,

For whom the Lord loves He corrects, even as a father corrects the son in whom he <u>delights</u>. (3:11-12 AMP)

If you <u>refuse</u> to discipline your children, it <u>proves</u> you don't love them;

if you love your children, you will be <u>prompt</u> to discipline them. (13:24 NLT)

A <u>fool spurns</u> his father's discipline, but whoever <u>heeds</u> correction shows <u>prudence</u>. (15:5 NIV)

Discipline your son while there is <u>hope</u>, but do not [<u>indulge</u> your angry resentments by <u>undue</u> chastisements and] set yourself to his <u>ruin</u>. (19:18 AMP)

Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a <u>child</u>; The <u>rod</u> of discipline will <u>remove</u> it far from him. (22:15 NASB)

Don't <u>fail</u> to <u>correct</u> your children. They won't die if you <u>spank</u> them. Physical discipline may well <u>save</u> them from death. (23:13-14 NLT)

Discipline your children, and they will give you happiness and peace of mind. (29:17 NLT)
