## 32. Levi & The Tribe of Levi

The sons of Leah; Reuben, Jacob's firstborn, and Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Zebulun ... (Genesis 35:23 KJV)

... the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations; <u>Gershon</u>, and <u>Kohath</u>, and <u>Merari</u>: and the years of the life of Levi were an hundred <u>thirty</u> and seven years.

... sons of Gershon; Libni, and Shimi ... sons of Kohath; Amram, and Izhar, and Hebron, and Uzziel ... sons of Merari; Mahali and Mushi: these are the families of Levi ....

And Amram took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife; and she bare him Aaron and Moses: and the years of the life of Amram were an hundred and thirty and seven years. (Exodus 6:16-20 KJV)

... Moses stood in the <u>gate</u> of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD's side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered <u>themselves</u> together unto him.

And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate <u>throughout</u> the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his <u>companion</u>, and every man his <u>neighbour</u>.

And the children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day about <u>three</u> thousand men. (Exodus 32:26-29 KJV)

They were counted by <u>families</u>--all the men of Israel who were twenty years old or <u>older</u> and able to go to <u>war</u>. The <u>total</u> number was 603,550 ... total did not include the Levites. For the LORD had said to Moses, "<u>Exempt</u> the tribe of Levi from the <u>census</u>; do not include them when you <u>count</u> ... You must put the Levites in charge of the <u>Tabernacle</u> of the <u>Covenant</u>, along with its <u>furnishings</u> and equipment. They must <u>carry</u> the Tabernacle and its <u>equipment</u> as you <u>travel</u>, and they must care for it and camp around it. Whenever the Tabernacle is moved, the Levites will take it down and set it up again. Anyone else who goes too <u>near</u> the Tabernacle will be <u>executed</u>. Each tribe of Israel will have a <u>designated</u> camping area with its own family <u>banner</u>. But the Levites will camp around the Tabernacle of the Covenant to offer the people of Israel protection from the LORD's <u>fierce</u> anger. The <u>Levites</u> are responsible to stand <u>guard</u> around the Tabernacle." (Numbers 1:45-53 NLT)
