And there came two <u>angels</u> to <u>Sodom</u> at even; and Lot sat in the gate of Sodom: and Lot seeing them rose up to meet them; and he <u>bowed</u> himself with his face <u>toward</u> the ground;

And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and <u>tarry</u> all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall <u>rise</u> up <u>early</u>, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will <u>abide</u> in the street all night.

And he <u>pressed</u> upon them <u>greatly</u>; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a <u>feast</u>, and did <u>bake unleavened</u> bread, and they did eat ... the men of the city, even the men of Sodom, <u>compassed</u> the house round, both old and young, all the people from every <u>quarter</u> ... called unto Lot ... Where are the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them ... Lot went out at the door unto them ... said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly.

Behold now, I have two daughters which have not known man; let me, I pray you, bring them out unto you, and do ye to them as is good in your eyes: only unto these men do nothing; for therefore came they under the <u>shadow</u> of my <u>roof</u> ...

But the men put forth their hand, and <u>pulled</u> Lot into the house to them, and shut to the door \dots they <u>smote</u> the men that were at the door of the house with <u>blindness</u> \dots so that they wearied themselves to find the door

Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon <u>Gomorrah brimstone</u> and fire from the LORD out of heaven; And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the <u>inhabitants</u> of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground.

But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a <u>pillar</u> of salt. ... the <u>firstborn</u> [daughter] said unto the younger, Behold, I lay <u>vesternight</u> with my father: let us make him drink wine this night also; ... that we may <u>preserve</u> seed of our father. And they made their father drink wine that night also ... and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose. Thus were both the daughters of Lot with child by their father.

And the first born bare a son, and called his name <u>Moab</u>: the same is the father of the Moabites unto this day. And the younger, she also bare a son, and called his name <u>Benammi</u>: the same is the father of the children of <u>Ammon</u> unto this day. (Genesis 19:1-12, 24-26, 34-38 KJV)
