

### 33. Lot, Abraham's Nephew

And there came two angels to Sodom at even; and Lot sat in the gate of Sodom: and Lot seeing them rose up to meet them; and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground;

And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will abide in the street all night.

And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat ... the men of the city, even the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter ... called unto Lot ... Where are the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them ... Lot went out at the door unto them ... said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly.

Behold now, I have two daughters which have not known man; let me, I pray you, bring them out unto you, and do ye to them as is good in your eyes: only unto these men do nothing; for therefore came they under the shadow of my roof ...

But the men put forth their hand, and pulled Lot into the house to them, and shut to the door .... they smote the men that were at the door of the house with blindness ... so that they wearied themselves to find the door

Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven; And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground.

But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt. ... the firstborn [daughter] said unto the younger, Behold, I lay yesternight with my father: let us make him drink wine this night also; ... that we may preserve seed of our father. And they made their father drink wine that night also ... and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose. Thus were both the daughters of Lot with child by their father.

And the first born bare a son, and called his name Moab: the same is the father of the Moabites unto this day. And the younger, she also bare a son, and called his name Benammi: the same is the father of the children of Ammon unto this day. (Genesis 19:1-12, 24-26, 34-38 KJV)
