## 40. Saul, The First King

<u>Saul</u>'s sons included <u>Jonathan</u>, <u>Ishbosheth</u>, and <u>Malkishua</u>. He also had two daughters: <u>Merab</u>, who was <u>older</u>, and <u>Michal</u>. (1 Samuel 14:49 NLT)

Now the <u>Philistines fought</u> against Israel; the Israelites fled before them, and many fell <u>slain</u> on Mount <u>Gilboa</u>. The Philistines <u>pressed</u> hard after Saul and his sons, and they killed his sons Jonathan, Abinadab and Malki-Shua. The fighting grew <u>fierce</u> around Saul, and when the <u>archers</u> overtook him, they <u>wounded</u> him <u>critically</u>.

Saul said to his <u>armor-bearer</u>, "Draw your sword and run me through, or these uncircumcised <u>fellows</u> will come and run me through and <u>abuse</u> me."

But his armor-bearer was <u>terrified</u> and would not do it; so Saul took his own sword and fell on it. When the armor-bearer saw that Saul was dead, he too <u>fell</u> on his sword and <u>died</u> with him. So Saul and his <u>three</u> sons and his armor-bearer and all his men died together that same day.

When the Israelites <u>along</u> the <u>valley</u> and those <u>across</u> the <u>Jordan</u> saw that the Israelite army had fled and that Saul and his sons had died, they abandoned their <u>towns</u> and fled. And the Philistines came and <u>occupied</u> them. (1 Samuel 31:1-7 NIV)
