43. The Levite's Father-In-Law

Now a Levite who lived in a <u>remote</u> area in the <u>hill</u> country of <u>Ephraim</u> took a <u>concubine</u> from Bethlehem in Judah. But she was <u>unfaithful</u> to him ... went back to her father's house ... After she had been there four months, her husband went to her to <u>persuade</u> her to return. He had with him his servant and <u>two</u> donkeys. She took him into her father's house, and when her father saw him, he gladly <u>welcomed</u> him. His father-in-law, the girl's father, prevailed upon him to stay; so he <u>remained</u> with him three days, eating and drinking, and sleeping there.

On the <u>fourth</u> day they got up early and he prepared to <u>leave</u>, but the girl's father said to his son-in-law, "<u>Refresh</u> yourself with something to eat; then you can go." So the two of them sat <u>down</u> to eat and drink together. Afterward the girl's father said, "Please stay <u>tonight</u> and <u>enjoy</u> yourself." And when the man got up to go, his father-in-law persuaded him, so he stayed there that night. On the morning of the <u>fifth</u> day, when he rose to go, the girl's father said, "Refresh yourself.
