45. Train a Child

<u>Train</u> up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not <u>depart</u> from it. (Proverbs 22L6 KJV)

Only be careful, and watch yourselves <u>closely</u> so that you do not forget the things your eyes have seen or let them <u>slip</u> from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them. Remember the day you stood before the LORD your God at <u>Horeb</u>, when he said to me, "<u>Assemble</u> the people before me to hear my words so that they may learn to <u>revere</u> me as long as they live in the land and may teach them to their children." (Deuteronomy 4:9-10 NIV)

You shall whet and sharpen them so as to make them <u>penetrate</u>, and teach and <u>impress</u> them <u>diligently</u> upon the [minds and] hearts of your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down and when you rise up.

And you shall <u>bind</u> them as a <u>sign</u> upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets (forehead bands) between your eyes. (Deuteronomy 6:7-8 AMP)

So commit yourselves completely to these words of mine. Tie them to your hands as a <u>reminder</u>, and wear them on your <u>forehead</u>. Teach them to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are away on a journey, when you are <u>lying</u> down and when you are getting up again. Write them on the <u>doorposts</u> of your house and on your gates, so that as long as the <u>sky</u> remains above the earth, you and your children may <u>flourish</u> in the land the LORD swore to give your <u>ancestors</u>. (Deuteronomy 11:18-21 NLT)

I have singled him out so that he will <u>direct</u> his sons and their <u>families</u> to keep the way of the LORD and do what is right and just. Then I will do for him all that I have promised." (Genesis 19:18 NLT)

For he established a <u>testimony</u> in Jacob, and <u>appointed</u> a law in Israel, which he <u>commanded</u> our fathers, that they should make them <u>known</u> to their children:

That the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should <u>arise</u> and <u>declare</u> them to their children:

That they might set their hope in God, and not <u>forget</u> the <u>works</u> of God, but keep his commandments: (Psalm 78:5-7 KJV)
