48. A Father's Discipline – Hebrews

You have not <u>yet resisted</u> to <u>bloodshed</u>, striving <u>against sin</u>. And you have <u>forgotten</u> the <u>exhortation</u> which <u>speaks</u> to you as to sons:

"My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD,

Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him;

For whom the LORD loves He chastens,

And scourges every son whom He receives."

If you <u>endure</u> chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?

But if you are without chastening, of which all have become <u>partakers</u>, then you are <u>illegitimate</u> and not sons.

Furthermore, we have had <u>human</u> fathers who corrected us, and we <u>paid</u> them respect. Shall we not much more <u>readily</u> be in <u>subjection</u> to the Father of spirits and live?

For they <u>indeed</u> for a few days chastened us as seemed <u>best</u> to them, but He for our <u>profit</u>, that we may be partakers of His holiness.

Now no chastening seems to be <u>joyful</u> for the <u>present</u>, but <u>painful</u>; nevertheless, afterward it <u>yields</u> the peaceable <u>fruit</u> of <u>righteousness</u> to those who have been trained by it.
