And when he came to *his* disciples, he saw a great <u>multitude</u> about them, and the <u>scribes questioning</u> with them. And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and <u>running</u> to *him* <u>saluted</u> him. And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them?

And one of the multitude answered and said, <u>Master</u>, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a <u>dumb</u> spirit; And wheresoever he <u>taketh</u> him, he <u>teareth</u> him: and he <u>foameth</u>, and <u>gnasheth</u> with his teeth, and <u>pineth</u> away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should <u>cast</u> him out; and they could not.

He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I <u>suffer</u> you? bring him unto me. And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit <u>tare</u> him; and he <u>fell</u> on the <u>ground</u>, and <u>wallowed</u> foaming.

And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child. And <u>ofttimes</u> it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have <u>compassion</u> on us, and help us.

Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things *are* possible to him that believeth.

And <u>straightway</u> the father of the child <u>cried</u> out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine <u>unbelief</u>. When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, *Thou* dumb and <u>deaf</u> spirit, I <u>charge</u> thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.

And *the spirit* cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; <u>insomuch</u> that many said, He is dead. But Jesus took him by the hand, and <u>lifted</u> him up; and he arose.

And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him <u>privately</u>, Why could not we cast him out? And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and <u>fasting</u>. Mark 9:14-29 KJV)
