65. My Father's House of Prayer

When it was almost time for the Jewish <u>Passover</u>, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. In the temple courts he found men <u>selling</u> cattle, sheep and doves, and others sitting at tables <u>exchanging</u> money. So he made a <u>whip</u> out of cords, and <u>drove</u> all from the temple area, both sheep and cattle; he <u>scattered</u> the <u>coins</u> of the money changers and overturned their tables. To those who sold doves he said, "Get these out of here! How dare you turn my Father's house into a <u>market</u>!" His disciples remembered that it is written: "<u>Zeal</u> for your house will <u>consume</u> me." (John 2:13-17 NIV)

And Jesus went into the <u>temple</u> of God, and cast out all them that <u>sold</u> and <u>bought</u> in the temple, and <u>overthrew</u> the <u>tables</u> of the <u>moneychangers</u>, and the <u>seats</u> of them that sold <u>doves</u>, And said unto them, It is <u>written</u>, My house shall be called the house of <u>prayer</u>; but ye have made it a <u>den</u> of <u>thieves</u>. And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple; and he healed them. And when the chief priests and <u>scribes</u> saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, <u>Hosanna</u> to the Son of David; they were sore <u>displeased</u>, And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and <u>sucklings</u> thou hast perfected praise? And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he <u>lodged</u> there. (Matthew 21:12-17 KJV)

When they arrived back in Jerusalem, Jesus entered the Temple and began to drive out the <u>merchants</u> and their <u>customers</u>. He knocked over the tables of the money changers and the <u>stalls</u> of those selling doves, and he stopped everyone from bringing in merchandise. He taught them, "The Scriptures declare, 'My Temple will be called a place of prayer for all nations,' but you have turned it into a den of thieves." (Mark 11:15-17 NLT)
