70. Paul, Spiritual Father to Timothy

I am not writing these things to <u>shame</u> you, but to <u>warn</u> you as my beloved children. For even if you had ten <u>thousand</u> others to teach you about Christ, you have only one <u>spiritual</u> father. For I became your father in Christ Jesus when I preached the Good News to you. So I ask you to follow my example and do as I do.

That is the very reason I am sending Timothy—to help you do this. For he is my beloved and <u>trustworthy</u> child in the Lord. He will <u>remind</u> you of what I teach about Christ Jesus in all the churches wherever I go.

I know that some of you have become <u>arrogant</u>, thinking I will never <u>visit</u> you again. But I will come—and <u>soon</u>—if the Lord will let me, and then I'll find out whether these arrogant people are just big <u>talkers</u> or whether they really have God's power. For the Kingdom of God is not just <u>fancy</u> talk; it is living by God's power. Which do you choose? Should I come with <u>punishment</u> and <u>scolding</u>, or should I come with <u>quiet</u> love and <u>gentleness</u>? (1 Corinthians 4:14-21 KJV)

To Timothy, my dear son:

Grace, <u>mercy</u> and <u>peace</u> from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

I thank God, whom I serve, as my <u>forefathers</u> did, with a clear <u>conscience</u>, as night and day I <u>constantly</u> remember you in my prayers. <u>Recalling</u> your <u>tears</u>, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with joy. I have been reminded of your <u>sincere</u> faith, which first lived in your <u>grandmother</u> Lois and in your mother <u>Eunice</u> and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also. For this reason I remind you to fan into <u>flame</u> the <u>gift</u> of God, which is in you through the <u>laying</u> on of my hands. For God did not give us a spirit of <u>timidity</u>, but a spirit of power, of love and of <u>self</u>-discipline. (2 Timothy 1:2-7 NIV)
