

## 73. Simon of Cyrene

### Mark 15:21

A certain man from Cyrene, Simon, the father of Alexander and Rufus, was passing by on his way in from the country, and they forced him to carry the cross. (NIV)

And they forced a passerby, Simon of Cyrene, the father of Alexander and Rufus, who was coming in from the field (country), to carry His cross. (AMP)

### Matthew 2:32-33

As they were going out, they met a man from Cyrene, named Simon, and they forced him to carry the cross. They came to a place called Golgotha (which means The Place of the Skull). (NIV)

And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear his cross. (KJV)

As they were marching forth, they came upon a man of Cyrene named Simon; this man they forced to carry the cross of Jesus. (AMP)

### Luke 26:23

As they led him away, they seized Simon from Cyrene, who was on his way in from the country, and put the cross on him and made him carry it behind Jesus. (NIV)
