## 80. Zechariah

In the time of Herod king of Judea there was a priest named <u>Zechariah</u>, who belonged to the priestly <u>division</u> of <u>Abijah</u>; his wife Elizabeth was also a <u>descendant</u> of Aaron. Both of them were <u>upright</u> in the sight of God, <u>observing</u> all the Lord's commandments and <u>regulations</u> <u>blamelessly</u>.
