11. Great Woman of Shunem

And it fell on a day, that <u>Elisha</u> passed to <u>Shunem</u>, where *was* a <u>great</u> woman; and she <u>constrained</u> him to eat bread. And *so* it was, *that* as oft as he passed by, he turned in <u>thither</u> to eat bread. And she said unto her husband, <u>Behold</u> now, I <u>perceive</u> that this *is* an holy man of God, which <u>passeth</u> by us continually. Let us make a little <u>chamber</u>, I pray thee, on the wall; and let us set for him there a <u>bed</u>, and a <u>table</u>, and a <u>stool</u>, and a <u>candlestick</u>: and it shall be, when he cometh to us, that he shall turn in thither.

And it fell on a day, that he came thither, and he turned into the chamber, and lay there. And he said to <u>Gehazi</u> his servant, Call this <u>Shunammite</u>. And when he had called her, she stood before him.

And he said, What then *is* to be done for her? And Gehazi answered, Verily she hath no <u>child</u>, and her husband is old. And he said, Call her. And when he had called her, she stood in the <u>door</u>. And he said, About this season, according to the time of life, thou shalt <u>embrace</u> a son. And she said, Nay, my lord, *thou* man of God, do not lie unto thine <u>handmaid</u>. And the woman <u>conceived</u>, and bare a son at that <u>season</u> that Elisha had said unto her, according to the time of life.

And when the child was <u>grown</u>, it fell on a day, that he went out to his father to the <u>reapers</u>. And he said unto his father, My <u>head</u>, my head. And he said to a lad, Carry him to his mother. And when he had taken him, and brought him to his mother, he sat on her <u>knees</u> till noon, and *then* died. And she went up, and <u>laid</u> him on the bed of the man of God, and shut *the door* upon him, and went out.

And when Elisha was come into the house, behold, the child was dead, *and* laid upon his bed.

Then he returned, and <u>walked</u> in the house to and fro; and went up, and <u>stretched</u> himself upon him: and the child <u>sneezed</u> seven times, and the child opened his eyes.

Then she went in, and fell at his feet, and bowed herself to the ground, and took up her son, and went out.
