## 16. Jezebel

<u>Ahab</u> son of <u>Omri</u> did more evil in the eyes of the LORD than any of those before him. He not only considered it trivial to commit the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, but he also married <u>Jezebel</u> daughter of Ethbaal king of the Sidonians, and began to serve <u>Baal</u> and <u>worship</u> him. (1 Kings 16:30-31 NLT)

Meanwhile, the <u>famine</u> had become very severe in Samaria. So Ahab summoned Obadiah, who was in charge of the palace. (Now <u>Obadiah</u> was a devoted follower of the LORD. Once when Jezebel had tried to <u>kill</u> all the LORD'S prophets, Obadiah had hidden one hundred of them in two <u>caves</u>. He had put fifty <u>prophets</u> in each cave and had supplied them with food and water. (1 Kings 18:2-4 NLT)

Now Ahab told Jezebel everything <u>Elijah</u> had done and how he had killed all the prophets with the sword. So Jezebel sent a <u>messenger</u> to Elijah to say, "May the gods deal with me, be it ever so severely, if by this time tomorrow I do not make your life like that of one of them." Elijah was afraid and ran for his life. (1 Kings 19:1-3 NIV)

... after these things ... <u>Naboth</u> the Jezreelite had a vineyard, which *was* in Jezreel, hard by the <u>palace</u> of Ahab ... Ahab spake unto Naboth, saying, Give me thy vineyard, that I may have it for a <u>garden</u> of <u>herbs</u>, ... Naboth said to Ahab, The LORD <u>forbid</u> it me, that I should give the <u>inheritance</u> of my fathers unto thee. And Ahab came into his house <u>heavy</u> and displeased ... But Jezebel his wife came to him, and said unto him, Why is thy spirit so sad, that thou eatest no <u>bread</u> ... Dost thou now govern the kingdom of Israel? ... I will give the the vineyard ... she wrote letters in Ahab's name ... unto the elders and to the <u>nobles</u> ... saying, <u>Proclaim</u> a fast, and set Naboth on high among the people: And set two men, sons of Belial, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst <u>blaspheme</u> God and the king. And *then* carry him out, and <u>stone</u> him, that he may die ... And the men of his city ... did as Jezebel had sent unto them (1 Kings 21:1-11 KJV)

"This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says ... I will avenge the <u>murder</u> of my prophets and all the LORD'S servants who were killed by Jezebel. The entire family of Ahab must be <u>wiped</u> out ... <u>Dogs</u> will eat Ahab's wife, Jezebel, at the <u>plot</u> of land in Jezreel, and no one will <u>bury</u> her. (2 Kings 9:6-10 NLT)
