18. Leah

And <u>Laban</u> had two <u>daughters</u> ... the <u>elder</u> was <u>Leah</u>, and ... younger was <u>Rachel</u>. Leah was <u>tender</u> eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favoured. And Jacob loved Rachel; and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter ...

And <u>Jacob</u> served seven years for Rachel; and they seemed unto him *but* a few days, for the love he had to her...And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and <u>brought</u> her to him; and he went in unto her ... And it came to pass, that in the <u>morning</u>, behold, it *was* Leah: and he said to Laban, What *is* this thou hast done unto me? did not I serve with thee for Rachel? <u>wherefore</u> then hast thou <u>beguiled</u> me?

And he went in also unto Rachel, and he loved also Rachel more than Leah, and served with him yet seven other years. And when the LORD saw that Leah *was* <u>hated</u>, he opened her womb: but Rachel *was* barren ...

And Leah conceived, and bare a son, and she called his name <u>Reuben</u>: for she said, Surely the LORD hath looked upon my <u>affliction</u>; now therefore my husband will love me...

And she conceived again ... <u>Simeon</u> ... <u>Levi</u> ... <u>Judah</u> ...

And Leah said, A <u>troop cometh</u>: ... <u>Gad</u>. And <u>Zilpah</u> Leah's maid bare Jacob a second son. And Leah said, Happy am I, for the daughters will call me blessed: and she called his name <u>Asher</u>.

And she said unto her [Rachel], *Is it* a small matter that thou hast taken my husband? and wouldest thou take away my son's mandrakes also? And Rachel said, Therefore he shall lie with thee to night for thy son's <u>mandrakes</u>...

... <u>Issachar</u> ... Then she [Leah] became <u>pregnant</u> again and had a <u>sixth</u> son. She named him <u>Zebulun</u>, for she said, "God has given me good gifts for my husband. Now he will <u>honor</u> me, for I have given him six sons." Later she gave birth to a daughter and named her <u>Dinah</u>....
