20. Maid of Naaman's Wife

Now <u>Naaman</u>, <u>captain</u> of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and <u>honourable</u>, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a <u>mighty</u> man in <u>valour</u>, *but he was* a <u>leper</u>. ²And the Syrians had gone out by companies, and had brought away <u>captive</u> out of the land of Israel a little <u>maid</u>; and she waited on Naaman's wife. ³And she said unto her <u>mistress</u>, Would God my lord *were* with the <u>prophet</u> that *is* in <u>Samaria</u>! for he would <u>recover</u> him of his leprosy. ⁴And *one* went in, and told his lord, saying, Thus and thus said the maid that *is* of the land of Israel.

And the king of <u>Syria</u> said, Go to, go, and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel. And he <u>departed</u>, and took with him ten <u>talents</u> of silver, and six <u>thousand pieces</u> of gold, and ten changes of <u>raiment</u>. ⁶And he brought the letter to the king of Israel, saying, Now when this letter is come unto thee, behold, I have *therewith* sent Naaman my servant to thee, that thou <u>mayest</u> recover him of his leprosy. ⁷And it came to pass, when the king of Israel had read the <u>letter</u>, that he rent his clothes, and said, *Am* I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man doth send unto me to recover a man of his leprosy? wherefore <u>consider</u>, I pray you, and see how he seeketh a <u>quarrel</u> against me.

And it was *so*, when Elisha the man of God had heard that the king of Israel had <u>rent</u> his clothes, that he sent to the king, saying, Wherefore hast thou rent thy clothes? let him come now to me, and he shall know that there is a prophet in Israel.

⁹So Naaman came with his <u>horses</u> and with his <u>chariot</u>, and stood at the door of the house of Elisha.

Then went he down, and <u>dipped</u> himself seven times in <u>Jordan</u>, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a <u>little</u> child, and he was <u>clean</u>.

¹⁵And he returned to the man of God, he and all his <u>company</u>, and came, and stood <u>before</u> him: and he said, Behold, now I know that *there is* no God in all the earth, but in Israel: now therefore, I pray thee, take a blessing of thy servant. (2 Kings 5: 1-9, 14-15 KJV)
