

## 22. Miriam

... Amram's wife was named Jochebed ... a descendant of Levi ... in the land of Egypt. Amram and Jochebed became the parents of Aaron, Moses, and their sister, Miriam. (Numbers 26:59 NLT)

... when she [Moses' mother] could hide him no longer, she ... placed the child in it [basket] and put it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile. His sister stood at a distance to see what would happen to him ... Pharaoh's daughter went down to the Nile to bathe ... She saw the basket among the reeds and sent her slave girl to get it ... Then his sister asked Pharaoh's daughter, "Shall I go and get one of the Hebrew women to nurse the baby for you?" "Yes, go," she answered. And the girl went and got the baby's mother. (Exodus 2:3-8 NLT)

... Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left ... when the Israelites saw the great power the LORD displayed ... the people feared the LORD and put their trust in him and in Moses his servant. (Exodus 14:29, 31 NIV)

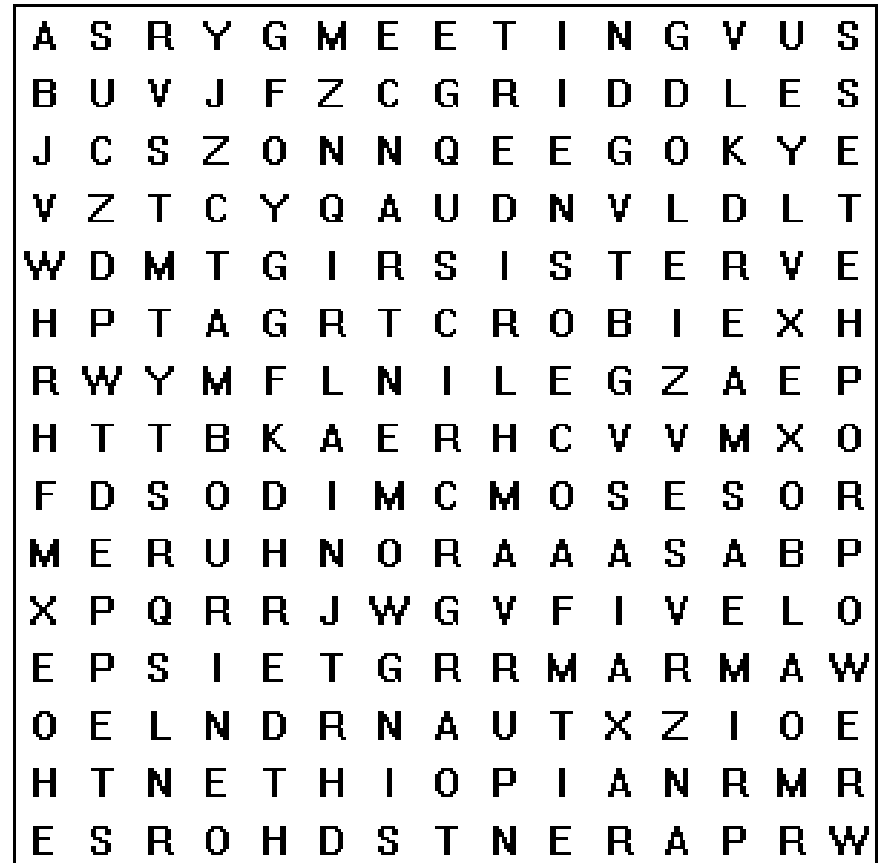
Then Miriam the prophetess, Aaron's sister, took a tambourine in her hand, and all the women followed her, with tambourines and dancing. Miriam sang to them:

"Sing to the LORD,  
for he is highly exalted.  
The horse and its rider  
he has hurled into the sea." (Exodus 15:20-21 NIV)

... Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married ... Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? (Numbers 12:1-2 KJV)

At once the LORD said to Moses, Aaron and Miriam, "Come out to the Tent of Meeting, all three of you." ... Then the LORD came down in a pillar of cloud; he stood at the entrance to the Tent ... When both of them stepped forward, he said, "Listen to my words:

"When a prophet of the LORD is among you, I reveal myself to him in visions, I speak to him in dreams. But this is not true of my servant Moses; he is faithful in all my house. With him I speak face to face, clearly and not in riddles; he sees the form of the LORD. Why then were you not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?" (Num. 12:4-8 NIV)
