22. Miriam

... <u>Amram</u>'s wife was named <u>Jochebed</u> ... a descendant of <u>Levi</u> ... in the land of Egypt. Amram and Jochebed became the <u>parents</u> of <u>Aaron</u>, <u>Moses</u>, and their sister, Miriam. (Numbers 26:59 NLT)

... when she [Moses' mother] could hide him no longer, she ... placed the child in it [basket] and put it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile. His sister stood at a distance to see what would happen to him ... Pharaoh's daughter went down to the Nile to bathe ... She saw the basket among the reeds and sent her slave girl to get it ... Then his sister asked Pharaoh's daughter, "Shall I go and get one of the Hebrew women to nurse the baby for you?" "Yes, go," she answered. And the girl went and got the baby's mother. (Exodus 2:3-8 NLT)

... Israelites went through the <u>sea</u> on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left ... when the Israelites saw the great <u>power</u> the LORD displayed ... the people feared the LORD and put their <u>trust</u> in him and in Moses his servant. (Exodus 14:29, 31 NIV)

Then Miriam the <u>prophetess</u>, Aaron's sister, took a <u>tambourine</u> in her hand, and all the <u>women</u> followed her, with tambourines and <u>dancing</u>. Miriam sang to them:

"Sing to the LORD, for he is highly exalted. The horse and its rider he has hurled into the sea." (Exodus 15:20-21 NIV)

 \dots Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the <u>Ethiopian</u> woman whom he had married \dots Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? (Numbers 12:1-2 KJV)

At once the LORD said to Moses, Aaron and Miriam, "Come out to the <u>Tent</u> of <u>Meeting</u>, all three of you." ... Then the LORD came down in a pillar of cloud; he stood at the <u>entrance</u> to the Tent ... When both of them <u>stepped</u> forward, he said, "Listen to my words:

"When a prophet of the LORD is among you, I <u>reveal</u> myself to him in visions, I speak to him in <u>dreams</u>. But this is not true of my servant Moses; he is faithful in all my house. With him I speak <u>face</u> to face, clearly and not in <u>riddles</u>; he sees the form of the LORD. Why then were you not <u>afraid</u> to speak against my servant Moses?" (Num. 12:4-8 NIV)
