25. Potiphar's Wife

Now when <u>Joseph</u> arrived in <u>Egypt</u> with the <u>Ishmaelite traders</u>, he was <u>purchased</u> by <u>Potiphar</u>, a member of the <u>personal staff</u> of <u>Pharaoh</u>, the king of Egypt. Potiphar was the <u>captain</u> of the palace <u>guard</u>.

The LORD was with Joseph and <u>blessed</u> him greatly as he served in the home of his Egyptian master ... Now Joseph was a very handsome and well-built young man. And about this time, Potiphar's wife began to <u>desire</u> him and <u>invited</u> him to <u>sleep</u> with her. But Joseph refused. "Look," he told her, "my <u>master trusts</u> me with everything in his entire household. No one here has more authority than I do! He has held back nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. How could I ever do such a wicked thing? It would be a great sin against God."

She kept putting <u>pressure</u> on him day after day, but he refused to sleep with her, and he kept out of her way as much as possible. One day, however, no one else was around when he was doing his work inside the house. She came and <u>grabbed</u> him by his <u>shirt</u>, demanding, "Sleep with me!" Joseph <u>tore</u> himself away, but as he did, his shirt came off. She was left holding it as he ran from the house.

When she saw that she had his shirt and that he had fled, she began screaming. Soon all the men around the place came running. "My husband has brought this <u>Hebrew slave</u> here to <u>insult</u> us!" she <u>sobbed</u>. "He tried to rape me, but I screamed. When he heard my loud cries, he ran and left his shirt behind with me."

She kept the shirt with her, and when her husband came home that night, she told him her story. "That Hebrew slave you've had around here tried to make a fool of me," she said. "I was saved only by my screams. He ran out, leaving his shirt behind!"

After hearing his wife's story, Potiphar was <u>furious</u>! He took Joseph and threw him into the <u>prison</u> where the king's prisoners were held. But the LORD was with Joseph there, too, and he granted Joseph favor with the chief jailer ... (Genesis 639:1-2, 6-21 NLT)
