27. Queen of Sheba

And when the <u>queen</u> of <u>Sheba</u> heard of the <u>fame</u> of <u>Solomon</u> concerning the name of the LORD, she came to <u>prove</u> him with <u>hard questions</u>.

And she came to Jerusalem with a very great <u>train</u>, with <u>camels</u> that bare <u>spices</u>, and very much <u>gold</u>, and precious <u>stones</u>: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart. And Solomon told her all her questions: there was not any thing <u>hid</u> from the king, which he told her not.

And when the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's <u>wisdom</u>, and the house that he had built.

And the <u>meat</u> of his table, and the sitting of his <u>servants</u>, and the attendance of his ministers, and their <u>apparel</u>, and his <u>cupbearers</u>, and his <u>ascent</u> by which he went up unto the house of the LORD; there was no more spirit in her.

And she said to the king, It was a true <u>report</u> that I heard in mine own land of thy acts and of thy wisdom.

Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard.

Happy are thy men, happy are these thy servants, which stand continually before thee, and that <u>hear</u> thy wisdom.

Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee, to set thee on the <u>throne</u> of Israel: because the LORD loved Israel for ever, therefore made he thee king, to do judgment and <u>justice</u>.

And she gave the king an hundred and twenty <u>talents</u> of gold, and of spices very great store, and precious stones: there came no more such abundance of spices as these ...

And the navy also of Hiram, that brought gold from Ophir, brought in from Ophir great plenty of almug trees, and precious stones. And the king made of the almug trees pillars for the house of the LORD, and for the king's house, harps also and psalteries for singers: there came no such almug trees, nor were seen unto this day.

And king Solomon gave unto the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside that which Solomon gave her of his <u>royal</u> <u>bounty</u>. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants. (1 Kings 10:1-13 KJV)
