## 44. Zipporah (Moses' Wife)

Now a <u>priest</u> of <u>Midian</u> had seven daughters, and they came to <u>draw</u> water and fill the <u>troughs</u> to water their father's <u>flock</u>. Some shepherds came along and drove them away, but <u>Moses</u> got up and came to their <u>rescue</u> and watered their flock.

When the girls returned to <u>Reuel</u> their father, he asked them, "Why have you returned so <u>early today</u>?"

They answered, "An Egyptian rescued us from the shepherds. He even drew water for us and watered the flock."

"And where is he?" he asked his daughters. "Why did you leave him? Invite him to have something to eat."

Moses agreed to stay with the man, who gave his daughter <u>Zipporah</u> to Moses in <u>marriage</u>. Zipporah gave birth to a son, and Moses named him <u>Gershom</u>, saying, "I have become an <u>alien</u> in a foreign land." (Exodus 2:16-22 NIV)

At a <u>lodging</u> place on the way, the LORD met {Moses} and was about to kill him. But Zipporah took a <u>flint knife</u>, <u>cut</u> off her son's <u>foreskin</u> and touched {Moses'} feet with it. "Surely you are a <u>bridegroom</u> of blood to me," she said. So the LORD let him alone. (At that time she said "bridegroom of blood," referring to <u>circumcision</u>.) (Exodus 4:24-26 NIV)

Now <u>Jethro</u>, the priest of Midian and father-in-law of Moses, heard of everything God had done for Moses and for his people Israel, and how the LORD had brought <u>Israel</u> out of <u>Egypt</u>.

After Moses had sent away his wife Zipporah, his father-in-law Jethro received her and her two sons. One son was named Gershom, for Moses said, "I have become an alien in a foreign land"; and the other was named <u>Eliezer</u>, for he said, "My father's God was my helper; he saved me from the <u>sword</u> of <u>Pharaoh</u>." Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, together with Moses' sons and wife, came to him in the <u>desert</u>, where he was <u>camped</u> near the mountain of God. Jethro had sent word to him, "I, your father-in-law Jethro, am coming to you with your <u>wife</u> and her two sons." (Exodus 4:1-6 NIV)
