5. Daughters of Zelophehad

The <u>daughters</u> of <u>Zelophehad</u> son of <u>Hepher</u>, the son of <u>Gilead</u>, the son of <u>Makir</u>, the son of <u>Manasseh</u>, belonged to the <u>clans</u> of Manasseh son of <u>Joseph</u>. The names of the daughters were <u>Mahlah</u>, <u>Noah</u>, <u>Hoglah</u>, <u>Milcah</u> and <u>Tirzah</u>. They approached the entrance to the <u>Tent</u> of <u>Meeting</u> and stood before Moses, Eleazar the <u>priest</u>, the leaders and the whole <u>assembly</u>, and said, "Our father died in the desert. He was not among <u>Korah</u>'s followers, who <u>banded</u> together against the LORD, but he died for his own sin and left no sons. Why should our father's name disappear from his clan because he had no son? Give us <u>property</u> among our father's relatives."

So Moses brought their <u>case</u> before the LORD and the LORD said to him, "What Zelophehad's daughters are saying is right. You must <u>certainly</u> give them property as an <u>inheritance</u> among their father's relatives and turn their father's inheritance over to them.

"Say to the Israelites, 'If a man dies and <u>leaves</u> no son, turn his inheritance over to his daughter. If he has no daughter, give his inheritance to his brothers. If he has no brothers, give his inheritance to his father's brothers. If his father had no brothers, give his inheritance to the <u>nearest</u> relative in his clan, that he may <u>possess</u> it. This is to be a <u>legal</u> requirement for the <u>Israelites</u>, as the LORD <u>commanded</u> Moses." (Numbers 27:1-11 NIV)
