50. Dorcas (Tabitha)

There was a <u>believer</u> in <u>Joppa</u> named <u>Tabitha</u> (which in Greek is <u>Dorcas</u>). She was always doing <u>kind</u> things for others and <u>helping</u> the poor. About this time she became <u>ill</u> and died. Her <u>friends</u> prepared her for <u>burial</u> and <u>laid</u> her in an <u>upstairs</u> room. But they had <u>heard</u> that <u>Peter</u> was <u>nearby</u> at <u>Lydda</u>, so they sent two men to beg him, "Please come as soon as possible!"

So Peter returned with them; and as soon as he <u>arrived</u>, they took him to the upstairs room. The room was filled with widows who were <u>weeping</u> and showing him the <u>coats</u> and other <u>garments</u> Dorcas had made for them. But Peter asked them all to leave the room; then he <u>knelt</u> and prayed. Turning to the body he said, "Get up, Tabitha." And she opened her eyes! When she <u>saw</u> Peter, she sat up! He gave her his <u>hand</u> and helped her up. Then he called in the widows and all the believers, and he <u>showed</u> them that she was <u>alive</u>.

The news <u>raced</u> through the <u>whole town</u>, and many believed in the Lord. And Peter stayed a long time in Joppa, living with <u>Simon</u>, a <u>leatherworker</u>. (Acts 9:36-43 NLT)
