55. Jairus' Daughter

As Jesus was saying this, the leader of a synagogue came and <u>knelt</u> down before him. "My daughter has just <u>died</u>," he said, "but you can <u>bring</u> her back to <u>life again</u> if you just come and lay your hand upon her." As Jesus and the disciples were going to the <u>official</u>'s <u>home</u>, (Matthew 9:18-19 NLT)

When Jesus entered the ruler's <u>house</u> and saw the flute players and the <u>noisy</u> crowd, he said, "Go away. The girl is not dead but <u>asleep</u>." But they <u>laughed</u> at him. After the crowd had been put outside, he went in and took the girl by the hand, and she got up. News of this <u>spread</u> through all that <u>region</u>. (Matthew 9:23-25 NIV)

And when Jesus was passed over again by ship unto the other side, much people gathered unto him: and he was nigh unto the sea. And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet, And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: *I pray thee*, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live. And *Jesus* went with him; and much people followed him, and thronged him. (Mark 5:21-24 KJV)

While he was still speaking to her, <u>messengers</u> arrived from Jairus's home with the message, "Your daughter is dead. There's no use <u>troubling</u> the Teacher now."

But Jesus <u>ignored</u> their comments and said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid. Just trust me." Then Jesus stopped the crowd and wouldn't let anyone go with him <u>except</u> Peter and James and John. When they came to the home of the synagogue leader, Jesus saw the <u>commotion</u> and the weeping and wailing. He went inside and spoke to the people. "Why all this <u>weeping</u> and commotion?" he asked. "The child isn't dead; she is only asleep."

The crowd laughed at him, but he told them all to go outside. Then he took the girl's father and mother and his three disciples into the room where the girl was Lying. Holding her hand, he said to her, "Get up, little girl!" And the girl, who was twelve years old, immediately stood up and walked around! Her parents were absolutely overwhelmed. (Mark 5:35-42 NLT)
