56. Jesus' Sisters

Jesus left there and went to his <u>hometown</u>, <u>accompanied</u> by his disciples. When the Sabbath came, he began to <u>teach</u> in the <u>synagogue</u>, and many who <u>heard</u> him were <u>amazed</u>.

"Where did this man get these things?" they asked. "What's this wisdom that has been given him, that he even does <u>miracles</u>! <u>Isn't</u> this the <u>carpenter</u>? Isn't this Mary's son and the brother of <u>James</u>, <u>Joseph</u>, <u>Judas</u> and <u>Simon</u>? Aren't his sisters here with us?" And they took <u>offense</u> at him.

Jesus said to them, "Only in his hometown, among his <u>relatives</u> and in his own house is a prophet without honor." He could not do any miracles there, except <u>lay</u> his hands on a <u>few sick</u> people and <u>heal</u> them. And he was amazed at their <u>lack</u> of <u>faith</u>. (Mark 6:1-6 NIV)

When Jesus had finished telling these stories, he left that part of the country. He returned to <u>Nazareth</u>, his hometown. When he taught there in the synagogue, everyone was <u>astonished</u> and said, "Where does he get his <u>wisdom</u> and his miracles? He's just a carpenter's son, and we know Mary, his mother, and his brothers—James, Joseph, Simon, and Judas. All his sisters live right here among us. What makes him so great?" And they were deeply <u>offended</u> and <u>refused</u> to believe in him.

Then Jesus told them, "A <u>prophet</u> is <u>honored</u> everywhere <u>except</u> in his own hometown and among his own <u>family</u>." And so he did only a few miracles there because of their unbelief. (Matthew 13:55-56 NLT)
