6. Deborah

And the children of Israel again did <u>evil</u> in the <u>sight</u> of the LORD, when Ehud was dead.

And the LORD sold them into the hand of <u>Jabin</u> king of Canaan, that <u>reigned</u> in <u>Hazor</u>; the <u>captain</u> of whose <u>host</u> was <u>Sisera</u>, which <u>dwelt</u> in Harosheth of the Gentiles.

And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had <u>nine</u> hundred <u>chariots</u> of <u>iron</u>; and <u>twenty</u> years he mightily <u>oppressed</u> the children of Israel.

And <u>Deborah</u>, a <u>prophetess</u>, the wife of <u>Lapidoth</u>, she <u>judged</u> Israel at that time. And she dwelt under the <u>palm</u> tree of Deborah between Ramah and <u>Bethel</u> in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

And she sent and called <u>Barak</u> the son of Abinoam out of Kedeshnaphtali, and said unto him, Hath not the LORD God of Israel commanded, saying, Go and draw toward <u>mount Tabor</u>, and take with thee ten thousand men of the children of <u>Naphtali</u> and of the children of <u>Zebulun</u>?

And I will draw unto thee to the river Kishon Sisera, the captain of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his multitude; and I will deliver him into thine hand.

And Barak said unto her, If thou wilt go with me, then I will go: but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go.

And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine <u>honour</u>; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. And Deborah arose, and went with Barak to Kedesh.

And Barak called Zebulun and Naphtali to Kedesh; and he went up with ten thousand men at his feet: and Deborah went up with him.

And Deborah said unto Barak, Up; for this is the day in which the LORD hath delivered Sisera into thine hand: is not the LORD gone out before thee? So Barak went down from mount Tabor, and ten thousand men after him.

Then sang Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam on that day, saying, Praise ye the LORD for the avenging of Israel, when the people <u>willingly</u> offered themselves. (Judges 4:1-10, 14; 5:1-2 KJV)
