At the Crucifixion and Burial of Jesus

And many women were there <u>beholding afar off</u>, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him: <u>Among</u> which was Mary Magdalene ... (Matthew 27:55-56 KJV)

The First to See That Jesus Had Risen

The first day of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the <u>sepulchre</u>. Then she <u>runneth</u>, and cometh to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and saith unto them, They have taken away the LORD out of the sepulchre, and we know not where they have laid him. Then the disciples went away again unto their own home. But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, and looked into the sepulchre, And seeth <u>two angels</u> in <u>white</u> sitting, the one at the <u>head</u>, and the other at the <u>feet</u>, where the <u>body</u> of Jesus had lain. And they say unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? She saith unto them, Because they have taken away my LORD, and I know not where they have laid him.

And when she had thus said, she turned herself back, and <u>saw</u> Jesus <u>standing</u>, and <u>knew not</u> that it was Jesus.

Jesus saith unto her, Woman, why <u>weepest</u> thou? whom seekest thou? She, supposing him to be the <u>gardener</u>, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take him away.

Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith unto him, <u>Rabboni</u>; which is to say, Master.

Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I <u>ascend</u> unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the LORD, and that he had spoken these things unto her. (John 20:2,11-18 KJV)
