63. Mary, Mother of Jesus

Now this is how Jesus the <u>Messiah</u> was <u>born</u>. His mother, Mary, was <u>engaged</u> to be married to Joseph. But while she was still a <u>virgin</u>, she became pregnant by the <u>Holy Spirit</u>. <u>Joseph</u>, her <u>fiance</u>, being a just man, decided to <u>break</u> the engagement quietly, so as not to <u>disgrace</u> her publicly.

As he considered this, he fell <u>asleep</u>, and an <u>angel</u> of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. "Joseph, son of David," the angel said, "do not be afraid to go <u>ahead</u> with your marriage to Mary. For the <u>child</u> within her has been conceived by the Holy Spirit. And she will have a <u>son</u>, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his <u>people</u> from their sins." All of this happened to fulfill the Lord's message through his prophet:

"Look! The virgin will conceive a child!

She will give birth to a son,

and he will be called Immanuel (meaning, God is with us)."

When Joseph <u>woke</u> up, he did what the angel of the Lord commanded. He brought Mary home to be his wife, but she remained a virgin until her son was born. And Joseph named him Jesus. (Matthew 1:18-25 NLT)

"Isn't this the <u>carpenter</u>'s son? Isn't his mother's name <u>Mary</u>, and aren't his brothers <u>James</u>, Joseph, <u>Simon</u> and <u>Judas</u>? Aren't all his <u>sisters</u> with us? (Matthew 13:55 NIV)

And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the <u>highest</u>, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the <u>shepherds</u> said one to another, Let us now go even unto <u>Bethlehem</u>, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us.

And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the \underline{babe} lying in a \underline{manger} ...

But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart. (Luke 2:13-19 KJV)
