64. Mary, Mother of Mark John, with Rhoda

Acts 12:11-16

And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a <u>surety</u>, that the Lord hath sent his <u>angel</u>, and hath <u>delivered</u> me out of the hand of <u>Herod</u>, and <u>from</u> all the <u>expectation</u> of the people of the Jews. And when he had considered <u>the thing</u>, he came to the house of <u>Mary</u> the mother of <u>John</u>, whose <u>surname</u> was <u>Mark</u>; where many were <u>gathered</u> together praying. And as Peter <u>knocked</u> at the door of the <u>gate</u>, a <u>damsel</u> came to <u>hearken</u>, named Rhoda. And when she knew Peter's voice, she opened not the gate for <u>gladness</u>, but ran in, and told how Peter <u>stood</u> before the gate. And they said unto her, Thou art mad. But she constantly <u>affirmed</u> that it was even so. Then said they, It is his angel. But Peter continued knocking: and when they had opened <u>the door</u>, and saw him, they were <u>astonished</u>. (KJV)

Then Peter came to himself and said, "Now I know without a doubt that the Lord sent his angel and <u>rescued</u> me from Herod's <u>clutches</u> and from everything the Jewish people were <u>anticipating</u>."

When this had <u>dawned</u> on him, he went to the house of Mary the mother of John, also called Mark, where many people had gathered and were praying. <u>Peter knocked</u> at the outer entrance, and a servant girl named <u>Rhoda</u> came to <u>answer</u> the door. When she recognized Peter's voice, she was so <u>overjoyed</u> she ran back without opening it and exclaimed, "Peter is at the door!"

"You're out of your mind," they told her. When she kept insisting that it was so, they said, "It must be his angel." But Peter kept on knocking, and when they opened the door and saw him, they were astonished. (NIV)

Peter finally realized what had happened. "It's really true!" he said to himself. "The Lord has sent his angel and saved me from Herod and from what the Jews were <u>hoping</u> to do to me!"

After a little thought, he went to the home of Mary, the mother of John Mark, where many were gathered for prayer. He knocked at the door in the gate, and a servant girl named Rhoda came to open it. When she recognized Peter's <u>voice</u>, she was so overjoyed that, instead of opening the door, she ran back inside and told everyone, "Peter is standing at the door!"

"You're out of your mind," they said. When she insisted, they decided, "It must be his angel." Meanwhile, Peter continued knocking. When they finally went out and opened the door, they were amazed. (NLT)
