12. Church Prayed for Peter

Act 12:1-16 KJV

Now about that time <u>Herod</u> the king stretched forth his hands to <u>vex</u> <u>certain</u> of the church. And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.

And because he <u>saw</u> it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.)

And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of <u>soldiers</u> to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people.

Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without <u>ceasing</u> of the church unto God for him. And when Herod would have brought him forth, the <u>same</u> night Peter was <u>sleeping</u> between two soldiers, bound with two <u>chains</u>: and the <u>keepers</u> before the door kept the prison.

And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he <u>smote</u> Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands.

And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me.

And he went out, and followed him; and wist not that it was true which was done by the angel; but thought he saw a vision.

When they were past the first and the second ward, they came unto the iron gate that <u>leadeth</u> unto the city; which opened to them of his own <u>accord</u>: and they went out, and passed on through one street; and <u>forthwith</u> the angel departed from him.

And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a <u>surety</u>, that the LORD hath sent his <u>angel</u>, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and from all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a <u>damsel</u> came to hearken, named Rhoda. And when she knew Peter's <u>voice</u>, she opened not the gate for gladness, but ran in, and told how Peter stood before the gate.

And they said unto her, Thou art <u>mad</u>. But she constantly <u>affirmed</u> that it was even so. Then said they, It is his angel.

But <u>Peter</u> continued <u>knocking</u>: and when they had opened the door, and saw him, they were astonished.
