15. Daniel Prayed Three Times a Day

Daniel 6:10:26 KJV

Now when Daniel knew that the writing was <u>signed</u>, he went into his <u>house</u>; and his <u>windows</u> being open in his <u>chamber</u> toward <u>Jerusalem</u>, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

Then these men <u>assembled</u>, and found Daniel praying and making supplication before his God. Then they came near, and spake before the king ... Hast thou not signed a <u>decree</u>, that every man that shall ask a <u>petition</u> of any God or man within thirty days ... shall be cast into the den of lions? ... Daniel, which is of the children of the captivity of Judah, regardeth not thee, O king, nor the decree that thou hast signed, but maketh his petition <u>three</u> times a day.

Then the king ... was sore <u>displeased</u> with himself, and set his heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

Then these men assembled unto the king, and said unto the king, Know, O king, that the law of the <u>Medes</u> and <u>Persians</u> is, That no decree nor <u>statute</u> which the king establisheth may be <u>changed</u>. Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast him into the <u>den</u> of <u>lions</u>. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou <u>servest</u> continually, he will deliver thee ... a stone was brought, and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.

Then the king went to his palace, and passed the night fasting: neither were instruments of musick brought before him: and his sleep went from him. Then the king arose very early in the morning, and went in haste unto the den of lions.

And when he came to the den, he cried with a <u>lamentable voice</u> unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O <u>Daniel</u>, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions?

Then said Daniel ... O king, live for ever. My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him <u>innocency</u> was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

Then was the king exceedingly glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God.

... king commanded ... those men which had accused Daniel ... cast them into the den of lions ...their children, and their wives; and the lions had the <u>mastery</u> of them, and brake all their bones in <u>pieces</u> or ever they came at the <u>bottom</u> of the den.

Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages ... Peace be <u>multiplied</u> unto you. I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and his <u>dominion</u> shall be even unto the end.
