## 16. Daniel for the Jews

## **Daniel 9:3-19 KJV**

And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and <u>sackcloth</u>, and <u>ashes</u>: And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and <u>dreadful</u> God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

We have sinned, and have committed <u>iniquity</u>, and have done wickedly, and have <u>rebelled</u>, even by <u>departing</u> from thy <u>precepts</u> and from thy judgments:

Neither have we hearkened unto thy servants the prophets, which spake in thy name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.

O LORD, righteousness belongeth unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, that are near, and that are <u>far</u> off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their <u>trespass</u> that they have trespassed against thee.

O Lord, to us belongeth confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have <u>sinned</u> against thee.

To the Lord our God belong mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against him; Neither have we obeyed the voice of the LORD our God, to <u>walk</u> in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets.

Yea, all Israel have transgressed thy <u>law</u>, even by departing, that they might not <u>obey</u> thy voice; therefore the <u>curse</u> is <u>poured</u> upon us, and the <u>oath</u> that is written in the law of <u>Moses</u> the servant of God, because we have sinned against him.

And he hath <u>confirmed</u> his words, which he <u>spake</u> against us, and against our judges that judged us, by bringing upon us a great evil: for under the whole heaven hath not been done as hath been done upon Jerusalem ...

And now, O Lord our God, that hast brought thy people forth out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand, and hast <u>gotten</u> thee <u>renown</u>, as at this day; we have sinned, we have done wickedly. O LORD, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be <u>turned</u> away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy <u>mountain</u>: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people are become a reproach to all that are about us.

Now therefore, O our God, hear the prayer of thy servant, and his supplications, and cause thy face to <u>shine</u> upon thy sanctuary that is <u>desolate</u>, for the Lord's sake.

O my God, incline thine ear, and hear; open thine eyes, and behold our desolations, and the city which is called by thy name: for we do not present our supplications before thee for our righteousnesses, but for thy great mercies.

O Lord, hear; O Lord, <u>forgive</u>; O Lord, <u>hearken</u> and do; <u>defer</u> not, for thine own sake, O my God: for thy city and thy people are called by thy name.
