17. David Prayer of Thanksgiving

2 Samuel 7:18-29 NIV

Then King David went in and sat before the Lord and prayed,

"Who am I, O <u>Sovereign</u> Lord, and what is my <u>family</u>, that you have <u>brought</u> me this far? And now, Sovereign Lord, in <u>addition</u> to everything else, you speak of giving your servant a lasting <u>dynasty</u>! Do you deal with everyone this way, O Sovereign Lord?

"What more can I say to you? You know what your servant is really like, Sovereign Lord. Because of your <u>promise</u> and <u>according</u> to your <u>will</u>, you have done all these <u>great</u> things and have made them known to your servant.

"How great you are, O Sovereign Lord! There is no one like you. We have never even heard of <u>another</u> God like you! What other nation on earth is <u>like</u> your people Israel? What other <u>nation</u>, O God, have you redeemed from <u>slavery</u> to be your <u>own</u> people? You <u>made</u> a great name for yourself when you redeemed your people from <u>Egypt</u>. You <u>performed awesome miracles</u> and drove out the nations and gods that <u>stood</u> in their way. You made Israel your very own people <u>forever</u>, and you, O Lord, became their God.

"And now, O Lord God, I am your servant; do as you have promised concerning me and my family. <u>Confirm</u> it as a promise that will last forever. And may your name be <u>honored</u> forever so that everyone will say, 'The Lord of Heaven's <u>Armies</u> is God over Israel!' And may the house of your servant David <u>continue</u> before you forever.

"O Lord of Heaven's Armies, God of Israel, I have been bold enough to pray this prayer to you because you have revealed all this to your servant, saying, 'I will build a house for you—a dynasty of kings!' For you are God, O Sovereign Lord. Your words are truth, and you have promised these good things to your servant.
